

Dear parishioners, I am sure that by this time many of you will already have heard the very sad news of the untimely death of Fr. Martin Chambers, our bishop-elect. The news of his death was relayed to us on Wednesday of this week, when we heard that the bishop-elect had died at home in his sleep only a couple of weeks away from his ordination as our new bishop.

After waiting for the appointment of a new bishop, following Bishop Robson's retiral, the news of Fr. Martin Chambers' nomination to the post by the Holy Father was most welcome, a time for us to look forward together as a diocese to new and hopeful things to come. This adds all the more to our sadness, hearing of Fr. Martin's passing and knowing what a friendly, faithful, and caring person he clearly was, and seeing the rich gifts that he would have brought through his ministry as our father in the Faith.

He will, of course, be mourned by his siblings who survive him - and who recently lost their mother also (Christmas Eve of 2023) - as well as by his friends, parishioners, and his fellow priests in the Diocese of Galloway.

Of your charity, I ask you, please, to pray for the happy repose of his soul, for the forgiveness of his sins, and for the reward of his goodness. Fr. Martin demonstrated a great generosity of heart in being willing to take on the burden of responsibility and the care of souls that comes with being a diocesan bishop. Although this call did not come to fruition, the Good Lord, I am sure, accepted Fr. Martin's "yes" to His will and will reward him accordingly. Pray for peace and consolation for his family and loved ones, and please remember too, in your prayers, Canon Kevin Golden our Diocesan Administrator who continues to carry the weight of the diocese on his shoulders until a suitable successor to Bishop Robson is found.

Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him. May he rest in peace. Amen. May his soul and the souls of all the departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.
